

### **Retail Prescription Card Plan**

The prescription card enables you to purchase short-term medications, such as antibiotics (maximum 30 day supply), by presenting your Caremark identification card at any participating nationwide pharmacy or independent community pharmacy.

<b>Retail (up to 30 days supply)</b>	
<b>Type of Medication</b>	<b>Co-pay</b>
Generic	20% (Minimum \$5)
Formulary Brand (Preferred)	20% (Minimum \$10)
Non-Formulary Brand with Formulary alternative	20% (Minimum \$20)

### **Out-of-network**

- 50% reimbursement of covered expenses - must file a claim form with Caremark for reimbursement under the prescription plan.

### **Mail Order Prescriptions**

The mail order program provides an inexpensive way to purchase maintenance or long-term medications such as insulin, blood pressure medication, etc. This program is available for prescription medications written for a 30 to 90 day supply. To use this program, simply mail your prescription along with a mail order form to Caremark. Forms are available on line at [www.caremark.com](http://www.caremark.com). Caremark will mail the prescription directly to your home address. You will receive your prescription within 14 days after Caremark receives your order. Refills can be ordered online or via telephone.

<b>Mail Order (up to 90 days supply)</b>	
<b>Type of Medication</b>	<b>Co-pay</b>
Generic	\$15
Formulary Brand (Preferred)	\$45
Non-Formulary Brand with Formulary alternative	\$70

**Note:** For all retail and mail order prescriptions, generic medications will be dispensed if available. If you or your physician requests a preferred brand medication, you will be charged the preferred or non-preferred co-pay plus the price difference between the generic and the brand name medication.
