



Ronnie A. Dunn, Ph.D., is chief diversity officer and associate professor of urban studies at Cleveland State University. As CDO, he is responsible for developing policies and practices that enhance diversity, equity and inclusion within the university and the broader community. He was named a National Association of Diversity Officers in Higher Education Fellow earlier this year.

Dunn's research interests include issues affecting minorities and the urban poor, with particular expertise in race, crime and the issue of racial profiling.

As chair of the Cuyahoga Metropolitan Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, on which he served for seven years, Dunn oversaw the provision of housing for over 55,000 residents throughout Cuyahoga County. He is also past chair of the Cleveland NAACP Criminal Justice Committee.
