#### Turn On



Select the **ON** button at the wall mounted controls. Then select PC or Laptop depending on whether you are using; the classroom PC or a laptop.

#### Raise or Lower the Monitor

There are 2 arrows on the side of the monitor, select the up arrow to raise the monitor and the down arrow to lower.



### Using the touch screen



You can use the optical touch screen to control your operating system. The touch screen can emulate basic mouse functions. The following table shows a list of gestures you can use on the touch screen.

Click	Tap the screen once.
Double-click	Tap the screen twice.
Right-click	1. Press on the target.
	2. Hold and wait for a blue ring to appear.
	3. Release your finger.
Drag	Drag one finger left or right.
Pan up / Pan down / Back /	Quickly drag your finger (flick) in a desired
Forward	direction.
Zoom	Move two fingers apart or toward each other.
Scroll	Drag one or two fingers up or down.

### Adjusting audio volume level

Use the volume adjuster on the computer and/or adjust the volume from the wall mounted control panel.

#### Turn Off Monitor:
