Hospitality Management Scholarship

Established in honor of former Tri-C Hospitality Management professor Mary Louise Coyne and in memory of John R. Schultz.

Criteria

- Minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Enrolled in Tri-C's Hospitality Management program.



Aramark Endowed Scholarship

Established in recognition of Aramark's longstanding partnership with Cuyahoga Community College, this fund supports students in Tri-C's Hospitality Management and Dietetic Technology programs.

Criteria

- Enrolled in a credit-bearing Hospitality Management or Dietetic Technology program.

Criteria

- Minimum 2.5 GPA.

- Preference given to recent high school graduates.
