

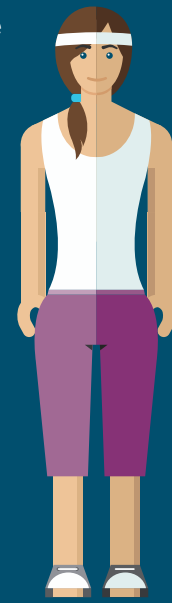
# Physical Therapy Pathway

## About Physical Therapists

Physical therapists (PTs) help people of all ages and abilities rehabilitate from devastating injuries, manage chronic conditions, avoid surgery and prescription drugs, and create healthy habits.

## Educational Requirements

Candidates must earn a doctor of physical therapy (DPT) degree from an accredited physical therapist education program and pass a state licensure exam. Professional DPT programs typically take three years to complete.
