- "The cost is reasonable but there are other burdens. The cost of time to print class materials is a burden. One of the books this semester only lets you print 2 pages at a time and there is a watermark on everything that makes the printout difficult to read."
- o I'm not a fan of the books you can purchase that you have to put in a three-ring binder, not because that's inconvenient, but because even with the ability to edit in the shrink-wrap and e-book format, there are still typos."
- "Sometimes, but math eBooks are ridiculously expensive."
- o "Some are very expensive, some are affordable."
- "Not always the prices can be ridiculous sometimes."



















Q7 Have you ever not registered for a course or dropped a course because of difficulty purchasing or accessing the required books and/or materials?




Q8 On average across all of your courses, how often do you use your books and/or materials throughout the semester?



Q9 Do books and/or materials your professors require you to purchase match the books and/or materials listed for your course(s) on the Barnes & Noble link provided to you during registration?



Q10 Have you gone into debt to buy books and/or materials?



Q11 Do you think that the costs of books and/or materials are reasonable?



Q12 How many credit hours are you taking this semester?








