What's Upward Bound Math/Science?

Upward Bound Math/Science helps students obtain the academic skills and motivation necessary for high school and college success. The after-school program provides college prep services and exposure to educational and career opportunities in science, technology, engineering, medicine and math (STEM).

Who can participate?

The Upward Bound Math/Science program at Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C®) serves students in the 9th, 10th and 11th grades at East Technical, Garrett Morgan and Lincoln-West high schools. Students and families must meet additional requirements established by the U.S. Department of Education. Contact program staff for details.

What does the program offer?

The following services are provided at no cost to the student:



After-school assistance in core academic subjects (English, math, science)



Student and parent support during transition from high school to college



Year-round counseling and advising



Financial aid advising and college selection assistance



Final exam and SAT/ACT prep



Monthly stipend



Six-week Summer STEM Academy



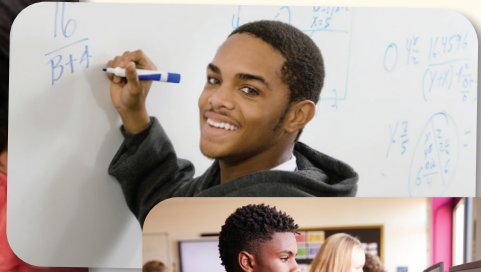
College and career readiness activities



College visits and fairs



Field trips, cultural events and personal development workshops



What does the program cost?

Students can participate in Upward Bound Math/Science at no cost to them or their families. Tri-C's program serves 56 students each year with funding assistance provided by the U.S. Department of Education.

What's required of students?

Upward Bound Math/Science participants must:

- Complete an application and interview process
- Maintain a 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA or higher
- Engage in academic support activities, workshops, cultural events and field trips
