BAC Wraparound Student Emergency Fund

The **BAC Wraparound Student Emergency Fund** is made possible through a generous grant from the **PNC Foundation** in support of Tri-C's **Skills to Succeed** campaign.

The grant is intended to help low- to moderate-income African American students overcome unforeseen financial challenges ("emergencies") that would otherwise impede their ability to persist in their studies.

Students may receive one award of **up to \$500** per academic year.

Emergencies include, but are not limited to:

- Technology and equipment needs
- Inability to pay for books and supplies
- Food insecurity
- Child care-related emergencies
- Inability to pay rent/housing costs due to unusual circumstances
- Unexpected health expenses not covered by insurance
- Transportation-related emergencies
- Unexpected loss of income

Eligible students must:

- Be African American
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours
- Have a FAFSA on file for the current academic year
- Complete the [BAC Student Emergency Fund application](#) and provide written documentation as requested

Awarding/Processing Procedure

Once a student's [online application](#) is approved, Tri-C's Student Financial Aid and Scholarships (SFAS) office will process the funds as follows:

- Funds will be applied to the student's account, and a refund request will be submitted to the Bursar's Office to be refunded as part of the normal schedule.
- The student will receive notification from SFAS that the process has been completed.
