

# Ohio College Tech Prep

The Ohio Tech Prep concept is a seamless, non-duplicative, integrated pathway of education and experience that starts in high school, continues through postsecondary and leads to success in the chosen technical career field.

The six Ohio Tech Prep Regional Centers serve as the liaison to Ohio's 91 career-technical planning districts, 23 community colleges and 14 universities to ensure high-quality career-technical education programs for students. The Regional Centers work with their education partners to increase student access to quality career-technical education pathways that provide opportunities to earn college credit while in high school.

## CTE Program Delivery Models

### 1 Comprehensive District

A comprehensive district is a Career-Tech Planning District (CTPD) in which all career-tech programs are delivered within a single district.

### 2 Compact

A compact is a CTPD in which multiple school districts have an agreement to offer career-tech programs between some or all districts. Students attend their home district for general education coursework and take career-tech programs at designated district buildings.

### 3 Joint Vocational School District

A Joint Vocational School District (JVSD) is a CTPD that serves at least two adjacent school districts and is governed by a JVSD school board. Most participating students attend the JVSD for career-tech training and complete general education coursework in their home district. Some JVSDs offer all-day programming.


