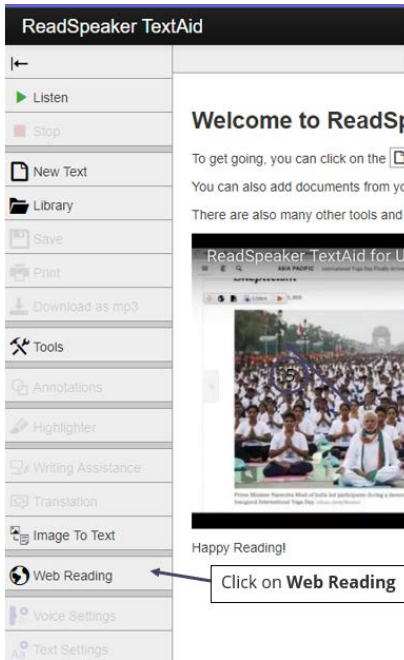


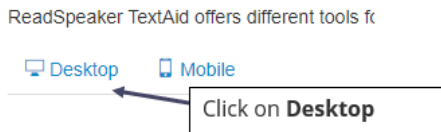
To add an extension in the browser, you will generally follow the steps outlined below. The example given is for the Chrome browser, but the other browser extension additions are similar.

1. Log into TextAid and click on **Web Reading**.



2. Now click on **Desktop**.

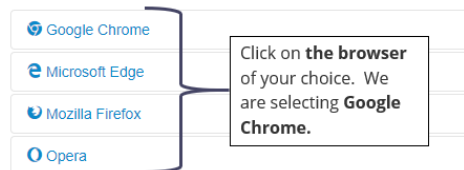

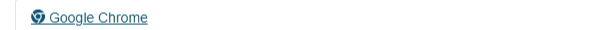
ReadSpeaker TextAid offers different tools for reading content outside of TextAid. Which tools are available depends on whether you are on a mobile device or a computer.

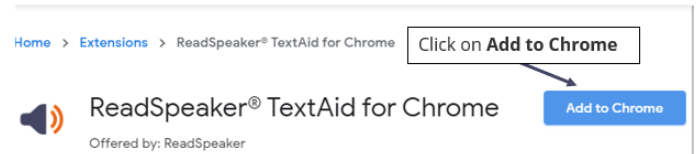

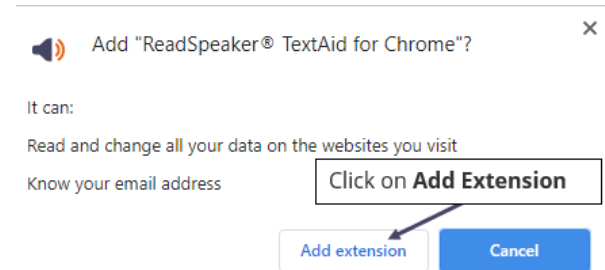
The extension will be added and you will see the ReadSpeaker icon on your Chrome
