# Accessing 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Applications in D2L's Brightspace

## General

Tri-C uses many 3<sup>rd</sup> party applications (apps) within our Brightspace Learning Management System. Each application might have a unique way of being accessed. Below is a list of 3<sup>rd</sup> party apps currently in use in Brightspace with access directions and resource links. Please note:

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# **3rd Party Applications (Apps)**

## Accessibility

#### Ally Accessibility Tool

Ally is an accessibility tool that is integrated within Brightspace. Faculty are encouraged to use Ally and the Ally Course Report to assess how their course content aligns with WCAG 2.1 AA (accessibility) guidelines.

#### Qwickly

*Qwickly allows instructors to send emails or announcements to students in more than one course at the same time.*

#### Remind

Although access to Remind is not available from within Brightspace, Remind can still be used through Remind's mobile phone app or by logging in to a faculty's Remind account. Once an instructor activates Remind for a CRN-based course, students will be automatically enrolled in Remind and instructors can then text message their students without sharing cell phone numbers.

#### Webex

Instructors and students can use the Webex Tool in Brightspace for meetings and office hours or a <u>Tri-C</u> <u>Webex account</u> can be accessed directly.

## **Student Interactive and Multimedia Activities and Assignments**

#### Hypothes.is

Hypothes.is is an annotation tool that allows social/collaborative annotations. Students can annotate on the same webpage/document.

Access in Brightspace: Go to the appropriate Content area > Existing Activities > External Learning Tools > Create New LTI Link > Add Title > LTI URL to Use (copy and paste this link): https://lms.hypothes.is/lti\_launches > Continue with creation

#### Mediasite

Mediasite is Tri-C's video creation, hosting, and delivery solution. Instructors can share videos in Brightspace and include quiz questions.

Mediasite videos can be added directly to a content area or in a file, assignment, discussion, etc. by selecting the Insert Stuff icon in the text box



#### Mediasite Video:

Link using Upload/Create: go to the appropriate content area > select Create a File > select the Insert Stuff icon > select Mediasite Link > select the presentation > select Link Video or Embed Video > select Insert > select Save and Close

Link using Existing Activities: go to the appropriate content area > select Existing Activities > select Mediasite Link > select the presentation > select Link Video

#### Mediasite Quiz:

Link: go to the appropriate content area > select Existing Activities > select Mediasite Quiz Link > select the presentation > select Link Video (verify grade center point value)

**Copy from Blackboard to Brightspace:** If a Mediasite video has been copied from Blackboard, the link for students will not work, please follow these instructions: <u>Recreate Mediasite link in</u> <u>Brightspace</u>

#### Nearpod

Nearpod is an online learning platform that allows instructors to boost student engagement by creating interactive content, lectures, and presentations.

Nearpod is not integrated with Brightspace, but faculty can add a link to a Nearpod lesson in a content area. Nearpod accounts can be requested by emailing olat@tri-c.edu.

#### Playposit

With PlayPosit, instructors can create and share interactive videos. Instructors begin with any online video and incorporate time-embedded activities to transform it into an active experience for students.

**To add an existing Playposit video:** Go to the appropriate Content area in Brightspace > Existing Activities > PlayPosit Interactive Videos

#### Softchalk

With Softchalk, Instructors can create interactive lessons that include activities, quizzes, videos and much more. The lesson can be synced to the Grade Center.

**To add an existing Softchalk lesson to Brightspace:** Go to the appropriate Content area in Brightspace > Existing Activities > Softchalk Link Selector

## ProctorU

ProctorU is Tri-C's virtual test proctoring service.

## **Respondus Lockdown Browser**

Lockdown Browser is a custom browser that locks down the testing environment within a learning management system, so only the test will open on the device. Please note, at Tri-C, Respondus Monitor is not used with the LockDown Browser for video monitoring a student while they take a test/quiz (see ProctorU).

Access: Select Quizzes in the top navigation bar of a course > select the LockDown Browser tab > select the dropdown arrow at the quiz that will use Respondus LockDown Browser > select Settings and complete the requirements including in the Advanced Settings > select Save + Close.

#### Respondus 4.0/4.1

Respondus 4.1 is a test creation tool and Respondus tests can be added to a Brightspace course. Most tests can be created right in Brightspace, but for unique situations, Respondus 4.1 might be an alternative option.

**To add a Respondus 4.1 test to Brightspace**: In Respondus update from 4.0 to 4.1 > change the Current Personality option to D2L Brightspace > then complete the Preview + Publish options.
