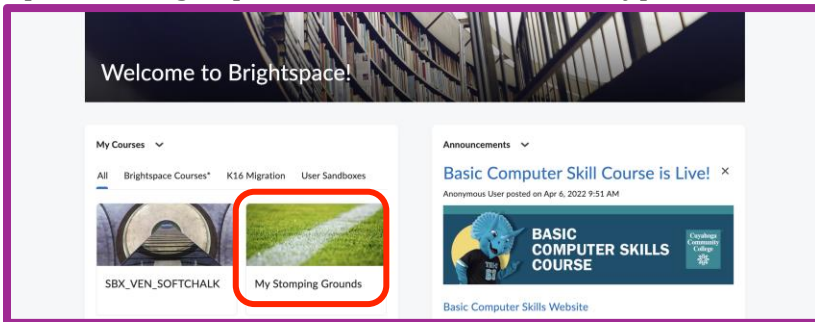


Adding Hypothes.is in Brightspace

Hypothes.is is a social annotation tool that allows users to add notes, highlights, and annotations to PDFs, websites, and other electronic documents.

Please note that the steps listed below should be followed each time a Hypothes.is assignment is added. If you try to use the "Hypothes.is icon" created in External Learning Activities after doing this once, you will remove the entire first assignment and student attempts.

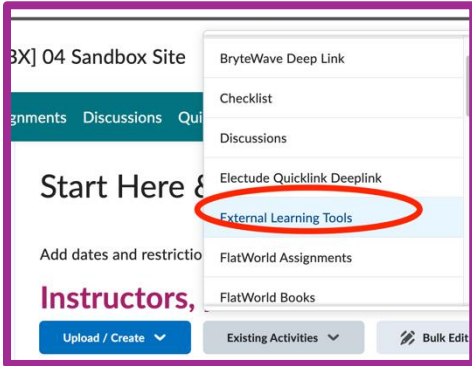
1. Open the Brightspace course site where the Hypothes.is lesson will reside.



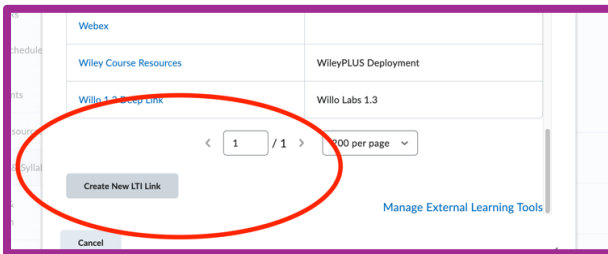
2. Navigate to the content area where the Hypothes.is assignment will go by selecting Content in the top Navigation bar and then the module.



3. Select on Existing Activities > External Learning Tools.



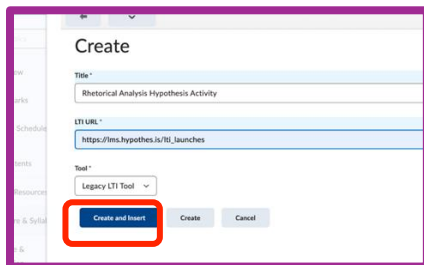
4. Scroll down to Create New LTI Link



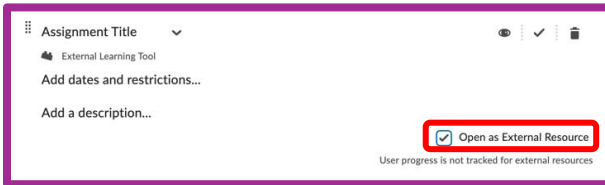
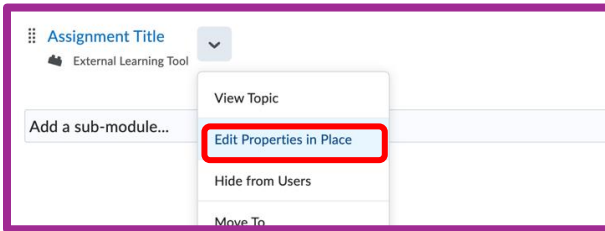
5. Add the name of the assignment. (You'll do this each time you add a new assignment for Hypothesis.)

6. Add the LTI URL to Use (copy and paste this link):
https://lms.hypothes.is/lti_launches

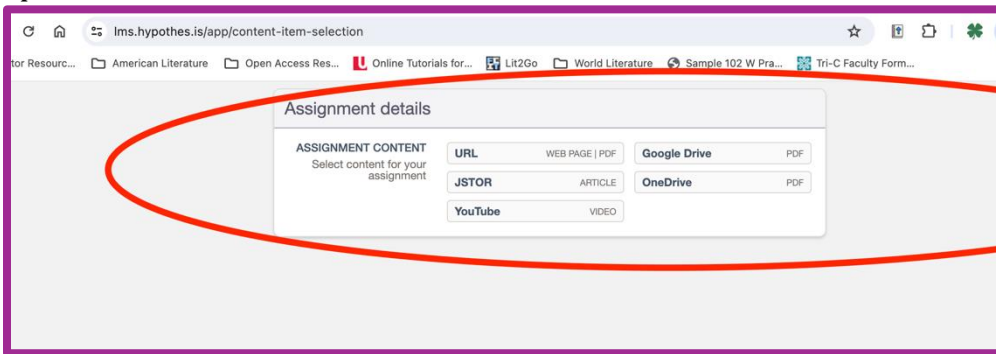
7. Select Create and Insert



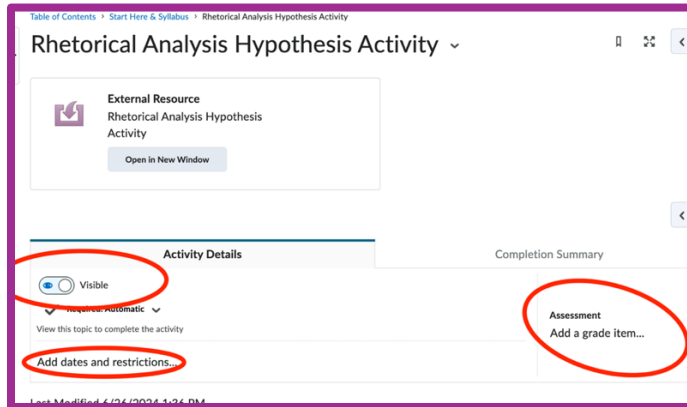
8. Select "Edit Properties in Place." Click Open as External Resource. You will likely have to refresh your screen.



9. Select on the title and then choose an assignment type. Add assignment document. If you upload files from One Drive, be sure to share using the share with anyone option.



10. If the assignment is being graded: In the Assessment box select “Add a grade item” > plus sign > complete the info > Save. Be sure to double-check visibility and the dates if there is a deadline.
