

Gen 1070 Resource Site for Brightspace Course Package

The Gen 1070 Brightspace course package is available in the FYE Gen 1070 Faculty Resource Site. You can enroll in the resource site, download the course package, and import it into a Brightspace course site. The content in the course package is the most up-to-date version of the Gen 1070 curriculum and includes the following:

- Complete Trek Guide PDF (2024 version)
- Brightspace modules for each Trek Guide Chapter containing:
 - Video introduction to the chapter featuring Tri-C students
 - PDF of the Trek Guide Chapters
 - Activities sub-module with all Trek Guide activities included as Assignments
- Pass/No Pass Grade Scheme
- Required Assignments in the Grade Book
- How-to-Article link to edit Assignments, making them visible and adding them to Grade Center

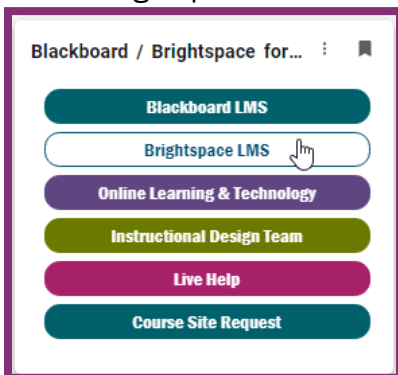
Quick Summary

Enroll in FYE Gen 1070 Faculty Resource Site

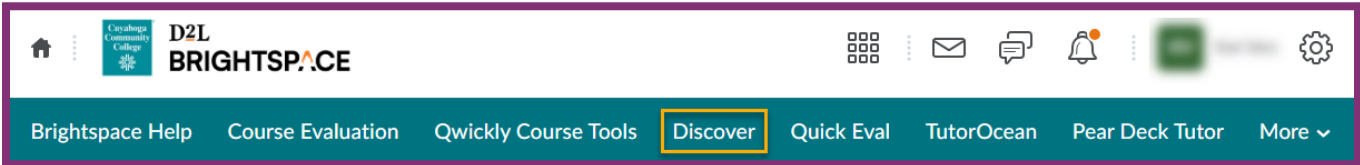
Step 1: Login to Brightspace

Select Brightspace LMS on the Blackboard/Brightspace for Faculty card in [My Tri-C Space](#).



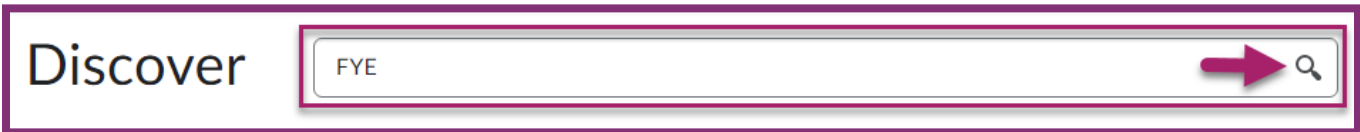
Step 2: Select Discover

From the Brightspace Home Page, select Discover. Tip: If you have been working in a course site, make sure to navigate back to the Tri-C Home Page using the Home icon to see the Discover link.



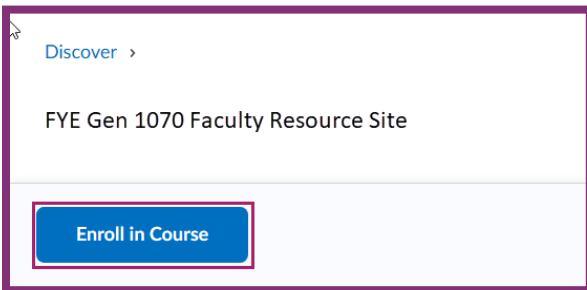
Step 3: Find a Course

All self-enroll sites will show up as tiles. You can search for the FYE Gen 1070 Faculty Resource Site by name using the search bar at the top by entering a search term and selecting the magnifying glass icon.

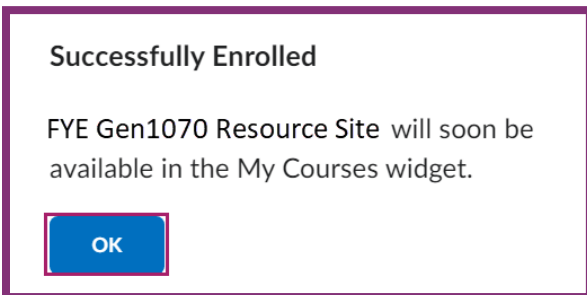


Step 4: Select Enroll and Select OK

Select OK.

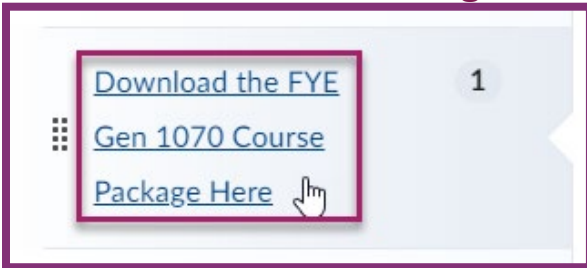


You are now enrolled in the course as a student.

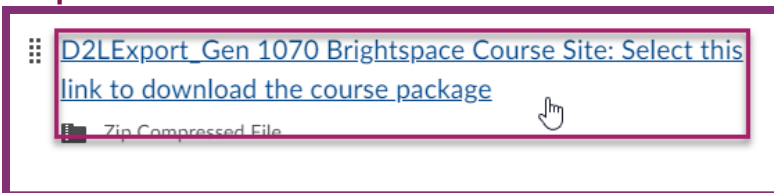

Download the FYE Gen 1070 course package

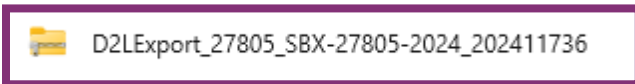
Step 1: In the FYE Gen 1070 Faculty Resource Site, select the module titled Download the FYE Gen 1070 Course Package Here

The file will download to your computer in the Download folder, unless you have selected a different location. The file will appear when it is done downloading.

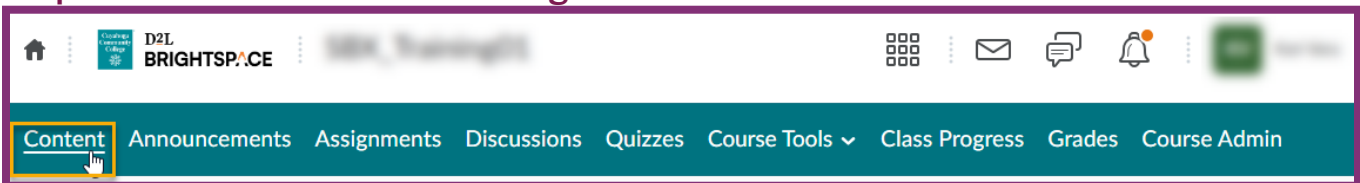


Import the course package

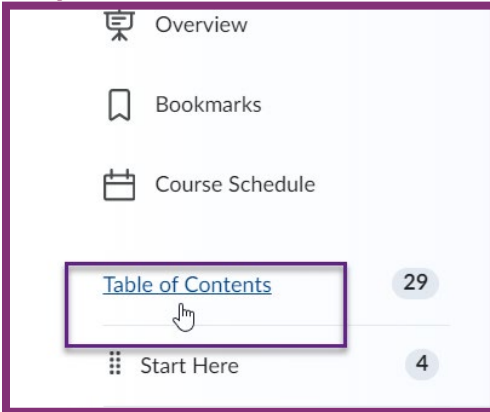
Step 1. Enter the Brightspace course where you need to add the content.

Step 2. Select Content on the Navigation Bar.



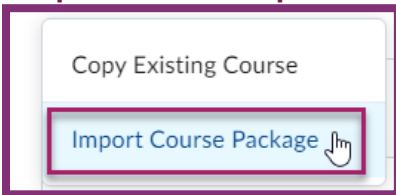
Step 3. Select Table of Contents from the course menu.



Step 4. Select Import Course

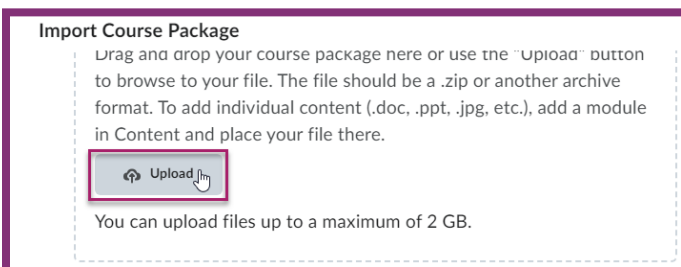


Step 5. Select Import Course Package

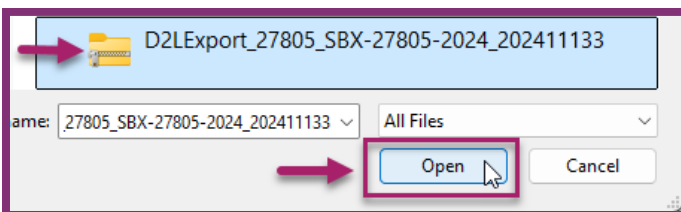


Step 6. Upload the course package zip file

Select the Upload button.



Navigate to the zip file on your computer. (Check the Downloads folder.) Select the file and select Open.



Step 7. Select Import All Components



Step 8. Select View Content to work on your course.
