

The Cuyahoga County Debt Repayment Program Scholarship

Through the Cuyahoga County Debt Repayment program, eligible Cuyahoga County residents may qualify for a one-time payment of up to \$2,000 toward debt to return to college and complete their degree at either Cleveland State University or Cuyahoga Community College.

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

- ❑ Have resided in Cuyahoga County for at least one year;
- ❑ Have been previously enrolled at a public higher education institution located in the state of Ohio and has been stopped out for at least one (1) semester
- ❑ Have previously incurred institutional debt from that institution that is currently preventing continued progression to certificate, degree or credential; (not including federal student loan debt)
- ❑ Seek to re-enroll at Cleveland State University or Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C)
- ❑ Meet federal Pell Grant income eligibility requirements through submission of a Student Aid Report or Institutional Award Letter.

PROCESS AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ❑ Bring the following documents to your appointment:
 - 2023/2024 FAFSA Student Aid Report (this can be done at your meeting if it has not been completed already)
 - Student tuition bill

This is a one-time scholarship that cannot be renewed.
