



Q2 How do you get your books and/or materials for your classes? (check all that apply)


Q3 If you use online resources, which do you use? (check all that apply)



Q4 What format for books and/or materials do you prefer?











Q8 On average across all of your courses, how often do you use your books and/or materials throughout the semester?





Q9 Do books and/or materials your professors require you to purchase match the books and/or materials listed for your course(s) on the Barnes & Noble link provided to you during registration?





Q10 Have you gone into debt to buy books and/or materials?













Q16 **** Providing feedback regarding your on-campus experience in the bookstore




