Course sequence may change based on the individual needs of the student and schedule type required.

New college students may be required during their first semester to participate in GEN 1070, First Year Success Seminar, a one credit hour course. See a Tri-C Counselor for details.

This represents an example of suggested courses to complete the Associate of Arts to continue for a bachelor's degree, which must total at least 60 semester credits and includes 36 Ohio Transfer-36 credits which are approved Tri-C general education requirements. OT36 details can be found at https://www.ohiohighered.org/Ohio-Transfer-36. Students should work closely with advisors at both institutions to discuss options.

^ Students must take Arts & Humanities courses from two different disciplines.

Although not directly equivalent to WVU's course the following will be accepted:

- ACCT 1311 and ACCT 1341 will be utilized as substitution for ACCT 201 and ACCT 202.
- IT 1090 is equivalent to BCOR 121 + BCOR 1TC and will be utilized as substitution for CS 101.

For this agreement, the following will be accepted as Lower-Level Major Electives (LLME):

• ECON 2010 = ECON 202

• BADM 2151 = BTEC 212 or

• BADM 1122 = BTEC 101

• MARK 2010 = BTEC 104

Students can select four of any 300/400 level course to satisfy their Upper-Level Electives at Potomac State College. Students can take additional Upper-Level course in place of their Lower-Level course if they wish while at Potomac State College.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
